The plan defines strategies to address housing, community development needs, and current market conditions in order for the city of Phoenix to make informed decisions on an estimated \$130 million in HUD grant funding. Grants include the Community Development Block Grant, Home Investment Partnership, Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS and Emergency Solutions Grant programs.
